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I. General Information about the Conference

Introduction

Abstracts must be submitted in English and should not exceed 250 words. Full submitted papers must be in English, not more than 10,000 words, including references with title of the paper, authors' name/s, e-mail addresses and affiliations. II. Selection and Paper Submission - Website

Types of Works

Three types of communications are admitted in the Conference: Papers, work in progress and posters.

'Paper' is considered the original research work, having completed all its phases.

'Work in progress' is considered the original work referred to a medium or long-term research project. It is mandatory that the works have the following structure: objectives, methodological aspects and foreseeable contributions of the study.

'Doctoral Thesis' is considered the original research work, completed or not, in which the authors look for a different interaction with the participants to the Conference.

'Poster' is considered the original research work, completed or not, in which the authors look for a different interaction with the participants to the Conference. The purpose of the poster is to encourage the person-to-person discussion about the poster's research. Authors will interact with the participants by standing next to the posters on the assigned day and schedule.

Review and evaluation of work abstract

- For each Paper, Work in Progress or Doctoral Thesis submitted, authors must fill in the form "Call for Paper - Registration" that appears on the web page. All the identification data must be completed.
- After the submission of the abstract, the applicants will be notified by email with further guidelines about the presentation.
- The evaluation is structured by conference areas. The committee will decide the area where they want to evaluate their work, although the author may ask to be reassigned to a different area in order to optimize the work of the scientific committee.

- Once the evaluation is completed, the management system will contact the applicant and notify them in terms of their acceptance.

Publication in the Conference Proceedings

Once the abstracts have been accepted, the authors can decide whether the abstract or full papers will be published in the Book of Conference Proceedings with ISBN.

Full Paper Submission Guidelines

After the presentation on the week of the conference, the participants can send the full paper by January 15, 2024.

- The submission of the full paper will be done by email: conference@universum-ks.org
- In the case of several works signed by more than one author, there must be a different effective registration for each of them. At least one different signatory per work must attend the Conference.
- In all cases, it is mandatory to use the template available **here “Full Work Template”**
- Failure to follow the rules implies rejection of the work presented.
- **Full Paper** is limited to **15 pages** normally, including all figures, tables, and references. **No more pages will be allowed.**

Documentation to be submitted

- The files will be written in Microsoft Word format (version 2003 or higher). The images, tables and figures must be inserted in the Word document in their corresponding place.
- Please save the paper with Name_Lastname Type of Work (e.x. John_Smith_Doctoral Thesis; or Jane_Smith_Paper).

Language

Authors should submit their full papers in English

Writing Guidelines

Maximum extension	For papers and doctoral thesis: 10 A4 pages including text, tables, graphics, appendices and bibliographical references (cover included). For work in progress: 5-10 A4 pages (cover included).
Margins and line spacing	All margins of 2.50 cm. Single-line spacing. Source: Times New Roman.
First page: Text: Titles of epigraphs: Sub-picture titles:	According to the template.
Summary:	Must be in English. According to the template.
Keywords:	From 3 to 7 identifiers. According to the template.
Headers:	According to the template. On an odd page: Job title (ellipses starting with the eighth word).
Feet of page:	Page numbering (Times New Roman, 9 points, bottom centered).
Enumerations:	Use of scripts only. Indent of 0.50 cm. Left and French bleeding of 0.45 cm.
Numbering of epigraphs:	Include the number of the main heading followed by a period and the number of the sub-heading followed by a new point.
Numbering of epigraphs: Tables (text or data) and Figures (graphics, diagrams or tables):	According to the template. First line: Term 'TABLE' or 'FIGURE' (according to case) and its priority. Second line: Title corresponding to the chart or table in question. The tables must be explanatory by themselves.
References:	Use APA format.

III. Presentation Instructions - Presenting the paper

Guidelines for presenting papers and work in progress

- Here are some general guidelines that may be useful to prepare your presentation:
- Try to be in the venue where the session is going to take place approximately 10 minutes before the start time of the session.
- The format of your presentation should be in Microsoft PowerPoint or web based that is supported by Chrome (*such as Prezi*).
- You can download the presentation from the Internet, but it is better to have it available on a USB stick. The rooms will have a projector and a computer with a current version of Microsoft Office, PDF document reader, browser and Internet connection enabled. We encourage the presenters to send the file or link the day before. If any speaker has additional needs, please contact: conference@universum-ks.org
- Online presentations will also be possible. All exact information regarding online presentation will be available to presenters in due time.
- Note that sessions have limited time and are usually assigned more than one presentation. Each presentation should **not exceed 10 minutes**. Subsequently, the audience and / or the moderator may intervene in the discussion time of each presentation.
- After 10 minutes of presentation, we will allow the panelists 5 minutes to address
